## **Key Themes & Insights:**

#### **Emerging Threat Landscape-**

The roundtable kicked off with a focused discussion on the evolving threat ecosystem. Participants examined next-gen risks including AI-powered phishing, deepfakes, ransomware-as-a-service, and potential vulnerabilities introduced by quantum computing.

#### Intelligence-Led Security Transformation-

Live demonstrations of Recorded Future's Intelligence Cloud illustrated how real-time threat intelligence enables faster detection, triage, and response. Attendees explored ways to embed this intelligence into SOC workflows and automate threat hunting at scale.

#### **Zero Trust & XDR in Action-**

From strategic overviews to real-world deployments, the group explored the growing adoption of Zero Trust architectures and Extended Detection & Response (XDR). Case discussions included multi-cloud visibility, policy enforcement, and identity management as control points.

### **Cross-Industry Collaboration & Culture Building-**

Executives emphasized the importance of CISO visibility at the board level and cross-functional alignment across IT, risk, and operations. Peer benchmarking enabled shared understanding of effective frameworks and resilient operating models.

## **Conclusion:**

The "Future of Security" roundtable was more than just a discussion — it was a call to action for cybersecurity leaders across industries. By bringing together a diverse group of senior executives in an intimate setting, ObserveNow and Recorded Future created a unique platform for honest dialogue, forward-thinking insights, and collaborative problem-solving.

- A clear call to action: With 93% of organizations planning to increase cybersecurity spending, and over 60% expecting budget growth of 20%+, proactive investment is non-negotiable.
- Zero Trust is essential and evolving: Around 43% have adopted Zero
  Trust, another 46% are in progress, and only 11% have not
  started—indicating it's a continuous journey.
- Emerging risks demand agility: Cyber budgets now make up 13.2% of IT spending (up from 8.6% in 2020), reflecting leadership's recognition of rising threats, including Al-driven and quantum dangers.
- Collaboration is key: As more organizations prioritize board-level engagement and cross-industry intelligence-sharing, these forums shift from conversation to action—empowering shared resilience.
