Panel Discussion 1: Generative AI Beyond Hype – Real-World Applications for Digital Natives

The first panel of the day set the tone for the summit by moving the conversation around Generative AI from experimentation to real-world execution. Moderated by Ravi Iyer, Senior Director of Engineering at New Relic, the session brought together some of the most influential technology leaders who are actively deploying AI at scale. The panel featured Gaurav Mathur, CTO of Licious; Kaushik Bhisht, Head of Engineering for AI Initiatives at Razorpay; Vikramjit Singh, Co-Founder & CTO of Headout; Divyanshu Singh, VP Engineering of Ixigo Trains and ConfirmTkt; Rama Subramani Ganesan, CTO of Portea; Anjani Kumar Jha, Chief Digital & Information Officer at Ather Energy; Ramkumar Venkateshan, CTO of Cashfree; Rakesh Patil, Co-Founder & CTO of Beyond Appliances; and Krithika Muthukrishnan, Chief Product & AI Officer at Scripbox.

The discussion focused on how digital-native organizations are moving beyond proof-of-concept AI implementations to building scalable, production-ready systems that directly impact business outcomes. Speakers shared insights on deploying GenAI responsibly, improving decision-making through data intelligence, and embedding AI into customer experience, fintech operations, logistics, and product engineering. The session highlighted how successful AI adoption today is less about technology access and more about governance, talent readiness, and aligning AI initiatives with core business objectives.



Panel Discussion 2: Cyber Resilience by Design – Embedding Security in Digital-First Businesses

The second panel focused on one of the most critical aspects of digital transformation—cybersecurity and resilience. Moderated by Krishnendu Dutta, Head of Information Security at Decathlon, the panel featured Shrenik Bhayani, Regional Territory Sales Head (SAARC) at Cloudflare; Mukesh Solanki, CISO at KreditBee; Jithendran C K, CTO at Blubirch; Kamesh Babu, CISO and Global Head of IT & Cybersecurity at Subex; Mrinmoy Dey, CISO at Lendingkart; Hilal Ahmad Lone, VP & CISO at Liminal Custody; Vibhav Chary, Vice President Engineering at FourKites.

The discussion explored how modern enterprises must shift from reactive security models to proactive, design-first security frameworks. Panelists spoke about zero-trust architectures, cloud security challenges, regulatory preparedness, and building cyber resilience across distributed digital ecosystems. Real-world case studies highlighted the importance of embedding security into product design, development pipelines, and organizational culture rather than treating it as an afterthought.



Fireside Chat: Redefining Leadership in an AI-Driven World – From Vision to Impact

One of the most engaging sessions of the day was the fireside chat that explored how leadership itself is being redefined in the age of artificial intelligence. Moderated by Dhanush J Suhas, Senior Solutions Consultant at New Relic, the conversation featured Atul Kumar, CEO – Online at PhysicsWallah, Nitin Jain, CTO of ShareChat, and Amar Prabhu, Co-founder & CTO of Rupee.

The discussion offered an insightful look into how leaders today must balance technological acceleration with human judgment. The speakers spoke candidly about leading AI-first organizations, building high-performing tech teams, and maintaining agility while scaling rapidly. They also addressed how leaders must adapt their decision-making styles, encourage experimentation, and foster a culture of continuous learning to remain relevant in an AI-driven ecosystem. The session resonated strongly with the audience by highlighting leadership as a blend of vision, adaptability, and responsible innovation.



Panel Discussion 3: Generative AI and the Future of Visual Intelligence

This panel examined how Generative AI is transforming content creation, visual intelligence, and digital experiences. Moderated by Yash Gupta, Co-Founder & CTO of Nova Benefits, the session brought together Aditya Patadia, CEO of Gumlet; Nitin Tiwari, Senior Data Scientist at Zelar; Vivek Srikantan, CTO at Spocto and YuCollect (Yubi); Ajay P V, Co-Founder of ShopOS; Sachin Nandwana, Co-founder of Bighaat; Pradeep Sharma, Head of Technology at CARS24; Vipin Kumar Tiwari, Director of Engineering - GenAI at Swiggy; Alok Srivastava, Head of AI/ML at Groww; and Sachin Jain, Co-founder & CFO of Procmart.

The discussion explored how AI is redefining content pipelines, personalization engines, and visual decision-making across industries such as fintech, e-commerce, agritech, and consumer platforms. Speakers shared how visual intelligence is enhancing customer engagement, automating workflows, and enabling data-driven creativity at scale. The session emphasized that GenAI is no longer experimental but a strategic enabler for competitive advantage.



Panel Discussion 4: Cloud-Native DNA - The Operating System of Digital Natives

The final panel of the summit focused on the foundational role of cloud-native architectures in building scalable, resilient digital businesses. Moderated by Sandesh GS, CTO of Bureau, the panel featured Saurabh Kumar, CIO of CaptainFresh; Sonu Gupta, Founder & CEO of CodersBrain; Manas Ranjan Hota, Co-founder of Drink Prime; Abhishek Kumar, Co-founder of Xoxoday; Mahesh Reddy, CEO of Go Pizza India; Biru Kumar, VP Engineering at Betterhalf; and Niraj Kumar, Director of Engineering at Shadowfax.

The conversation highlighted how cloud-native thinking enables faster innovation, better cost optimization, and seamless scalability. Panelists discussed real-world experiences in migrating to cloud-native stacks, managing distributed systems, and building high-availability platforms. The session reinforced how cloud infrastructure has become the backbone of digital-native enterprises, enabling rapid experimentation, AI integration, and operational resilience.



Guest of Honour Address

The summit concluded with a distinguished address by Dr. Sanjay Tyagi, Jurisdictional Director, STPI, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. In his address, Dr. Tyagi underscored the critical role of progressive policy frameworks, innovation-driven ecosystems, and strong public-private collaboration in accelerating India's digital economy. He highlighted how key initiatives under MeitY are empowering startups, enabling deep-tech innovation, and strengthening India's position as a global digital powerhouse. As part of the closing segment, Dr. Tyagi also felicitated select industry leaders for their outstanding contributions to the technology ecosystem, recognizing their efforts in driving digital transformation, innovation, and sustainable growth across sectors.
